



























Suggestions by Students based on Questionnaire

- 1. Doubt-clearing sessions must be held regularly to gaining conceptual celerity.
- 2. Industrial visits should be conducted visits to provide students with a practical understanding and corporate exposer.
- 3. Recommendations were made to integrate professional skills development into the curriculum from the beginning, offering workshops and courses on web design, Android app development, software testing, and other relevant fields, and to provide detailed roadmaps for different career paths.
- 4. It was advised to ensure placement opportunities are available for all specializations, including finance and analytics, to help students from all disciplines secure employment in their chosen fields.
- 5. It was highlighted that committing to completing the syllabus on time would ensure that students have adequate time to prepare for exams and assimilate the knowledge effectively.
- 6. There were suggestions to conduct more events on campus to foster a vibrant and engaging student life, ranging from academic seminars to cultural and recreational activities.
- 7. Institute must organize field excursion trips at least twice a year to provide students with opportunities for exploration, and learning outside the classroom.
- 8. College should increase the frequency of fests and celebrations on campus to boost morale, encourage student participation, team work and create a sense of community.
- 9. There were recommendations to provide more opportunities in the field of sports by organizing sports events and fests to encourage physical activity and teamwork among students.
- 10. College library with the latest editions of books to ensure that students have access to current and relevant academic resources.
















Suggestions by Alumni based on Questionnaire
