MEMBERSHIP AND E-WASTE OFF TAKE AGREEMENT

This agreement is made on 24th, June, 2022 between SPRECO RECYCLING, D-45, Industrial Focal Point, Raikot, Ludhiana-141106 (Punjab) here in after called Operator, Recycler, E- WASTE RECYCLING through its Managing Partner, Mr. Amanjot Singh.

Gian Jyoti Institute of Management & Technology, Mohali (Near Bassi Theatre), Sector-54, Chandigarh, Punjab 160055, India, here in after called Generator through its Director, Dr. Ancet.

- SPRECO RECYCLING is engaged in the collection of E-Waste and recycling.
- 2. The Generator desires to get its E-waste, being generated as per the requirement of Punjab Pollution Control Board to be collected by the authorized recycler, to which the recycler has agreed on the terms and conditions in this agreement.
- 3. The generator shall not sell the E-waste to any other person or bill to any other person. In case the generator sells the E-waste to any other person other than Spreco Recycling, the present agreement shall be CANCELLED.
- 4. The generator shall ensure that the E-waste is packaged in a manner which enables it suitable for storage and transport and the labeling and packaging shall be easily visible and be able to withstand physical conditions and climate factors, such packaging and labeling should be in full compliance of the rules.
- 5. Through this agreement, Spreco Recycling commits to providing E-waste collection services to the said generator.



- 6. Spreco Recycling shall provide the generator with all the details of the E-waste material that will be lifted from generator site whenever desired by the generator.
- 7. Spreco Recycling is also liable in disposing off material as per the regulations laid under Ewaste management and handling rules, 2011.
- 8. Providing information to Spreco Recycling regarding the generation of any kind of E-waste shall be entirely the generator responsibility over course of this agreement.
- This agreement shall be valid for five (05) years starting from 24/06/2022 to 25/06/2027.
- 10. This agreement may be modified or amended only by writing, duly executed by or on behalf of the parties hereto.
- 11. A person lifting the E-waste should have an Authorization letter.





Memorandum of Understanding

between

Gian Jyoti Institute of Management & Technology, Mohali

Asian Business School, Noida

Gian Jyoti Institute of Management & Technology, Mohali (GJIMT, Mohali) and Asian Business School, Noida (ABS, Noida) recognize their strengths in research and education in one or more disciplines of management and social sciences, and their mutual interest in engaging themselves in academic cooperation.

GJIMT, Mohali and ABS, Noida therefore agree to establish a programme for academic cooperation in the areas of mutual interest, and in accordance with terms and conditions set forth in this memorandum of understanding (MoU).

The goal is to foster collaboration, provide opportunity for global experience, and to facilitate advancement of knowledge on the basis of reciprocity, best effort, mutual benefit, and frequent interactions. GJIMT, Mohali and ABS Noida agree:

- to exchange information on research and educational programmes
- to exchange information on teaching, learning material and other literature relevant to their educational and research programmes.
- to jointly organize short-term continuing education programmes on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein
- to jointly organize seminars, conferences, or workshops on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein
- to jointly propose and engage in research or training programmes sponsored by funding agencies, and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein

GJIMT, Mohali and ABS Noida further agree that detailed terms and conditions that guide each activity identified above will be separately determined and agreed upon by the two institutions. These terms shall include a technical description of the proposed activity, financial arrangements, and person(s) responsible for its implementation, etc.

B. Joint Sponsored Research, Development and Consulting

GJIMT, Mohali and ABS Noida agree to help identify and invite faculty members from the other institution to participate in research or development programmes. The terms and conditions for such participation will be worked out by mutual agreement between GJIMT, Mohali and ABS Noida.

C. Exchange of Faculty and Staff

GJIMT, Mohali and ABS Noida agree to encourage collaboration between faculty and staff from the two institutions. Specifically, institutions will encourage members of their faculties to undertake short visits to, or take up fixed-term visiting assignments at, each other's institution as per the existing norms. Terms and conditions for each visit or an assignment, including those concerning, travel, and housing, name of the concerned faculty member will be worked out between GJIMT, Mohali and ABS Noida.

D. Joint Conferences, workshops and short-term courses

GJIMT, Mohali and ABS Noida agree to help identify and invite faculty members from the other institution to participate in conferences, workshops and short-term courses. The terms and conditions for such participation will be worked out by mutual agreement between GJIMT, Mohali and ABS Noida.

E. Intellectual Property

GJIMT, Mohali and ABS Noida agree to respect each other's rights to intellectual property. Further, the intellectual property rights that arise as a result of any collaborative research or activity under this MoU will be worked out on a case-by-case basis, and will be consistent with the officially laid down IPR policies of the two institutions.

F. Co-ordination

Each institution shall appoint one member of its teaching/research faculty to coordinate the programme on its behalf. Further, a coordination committee, consisting of (a) Director, GJIMT, Mohali, or his/her nominee, (b) Director, ABS, Noida, or his/her nominee, (c) Programme coordinator from the side of GJIMT, Mohali, and (d) Programme Coordinator from the side of ABS, Noida, will periodically review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between the two institutions.

G. Tenure and Termination

This MoU will take effect from the date it is signed by representatives of the two institutions. It will remain valid for five years, and may be continued thereafter after suitable review and agreement. Either institution may terminate the MoU by giving written notice to the other institution six months in advance. Once terminated, neither GJIMT, Mohali nor ABS Noida will be responsible for any losses, financial or otherwise, which the other institutions may suffer. However, GJIMT, Mohali end ABS Noida will ensure that all activities in progress are allowed to complete successfully.

H. Arbitration Clause

ABS, Noida

Should there be a dispute relating to any aspect of academic cooperation, Director, GJIMT, Mohali and Director, ABS Noida will jointly resolve the dispute in a spirit of independence, mutual respect, and shared responsibility.

This MoU is signed subject to approval of the respective academic/administrative bodies.

HANDICAP GRAB BAR


Handicap grab bars are safety devices that are specially designed to maintain the balance of a handicapped person. These are mounted on bathroom walls next to the toilet seat.




Braille Keyboard for Visually Challenged














