The institution has made significant strides in promoting gender equity and sensitization across its various programs and activities. These efforts are evident in several key areas:

Curriculum Integration

The institution has thoughtfully incorporated gender equity themes into its curriculum. For example:

Department of Management Courses: The department offers courses like 'Human Values and Professional Ethics,' which focuses on ensuring equal opportunities for women in society. This course aims to instil values and ethics that support gender fairness.

- Workshop on Indian Ethos: This workshop provides insights into management lessons derived from different Vedic texts, highlighting how these ancient teachings support and empower women, thereby contributing to their enhanced status in society.
- Business Ethics & CSR: This course addresses contemporary issues such as gender equity, women's leadership, and opportunities within the business world. It integrates discussions on how ethical practices and corporate social responsibility (CSR) can promote gender inclusivity.

Co-Curricular Activities

The institution actively promotes gender sensitization through a variety of co-curricular activities:

- Workshops and Seminars: Regularly conducted to raise awareness and educate students and staff about gender issues and sensitivity such as the celebration of International Women's Day, Sodashi where GJIMT honors and felicitates the Women Principals and Educators from various schools and Colleges.
- Guest Lectures: These provide diverse perspectives from experts on gender-related topics, enriching the community's understanding and engagement.
- Screening of Women-Oriented Films: These films are used as tools to discuss and reflect on women's issues and achievements, fostering greater empathy and awareness.
- Counselling Sessions: These offer personal and professional support, addressing any genderrelated concerns that students may have.

Safety and Empowerment Initiatives

The institution has implemented specific programs to enhance the safety and empowerment of female students:

Self-Defense Training: Aimed at equipping female students with skills to protect themselves, this program is a proactive measure to ensure their safety.



Awareness Programs: These include topics such as human rights, women's rights under the Prevention of Sexual Harassment (POSH) Act, and safety and security measures for women. Such programs are conducted regularly to keep the community informed and prepared.

Gender Audit and Committees

The institution has established a comprehensive framework to ensure gender equity and address grievances:

- > Career Guidance Development Cell (CGDC): This cell has conducted a 'Gender Audit' to assess and enhance gender practices within the institution. It organizes various gender sensitization activities, demonstrating a commitment to continual improvement.
- > Institutional Committees: The institution has set up several committees to address different aspects of student and staff welfare:
- Internal Complaints Committee (ICC): Handles complaints related to sexual harassment and ensures a safe environment for all
- Anti-Ragging Committee: Works to prevent and address issues related to ragging.
- Grievance Redressal Committee: Provides a platform for addressing grievances from students and staff.
- SC/ST Cell: Supports the well-being of students and staff from Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes.

The roles and functions of these committees are clearly outlined on the institution's website, and information is disseminated to students through orientation and induction programs, ensuring transparency and accessibility.

Safety and Security Measures

To ensure the safety and security of students and staff, the institution has implemented several measures:

- CCTV Surveillance: The campus is equipped with CCTV cameras to monitor and enhance security.
- ID Card System: Students must wear ID cards at all times, and visitors are required to pass through security checks and obtain visitor IDs.
- Dedicated Counselling Centre: This centre provides comprehensive support for academic, emotional, social, and cognitive development, ensuring that students have access to necessary resources and guidance. GJIMT provides Mental Wellness Programs that include counseling that supports to ensure students' emotional and psychological well-being.
- Personal Counseling: Available at various levels to address individual concerns and support students' well-being.
- Sanitary Facilities: Separate washroom facilities for girls and boys are equipped with sanitary napkin vending and disposal machines, promoting hygiene and safety.

These initiatives reflect the institution's dedication to fostering a gender-sensitive, equitable, and supportive environment for its community.





- To ensure balanced gender representation in decision-making processes across all college activities.


Gender Audit Concept and Methodology
