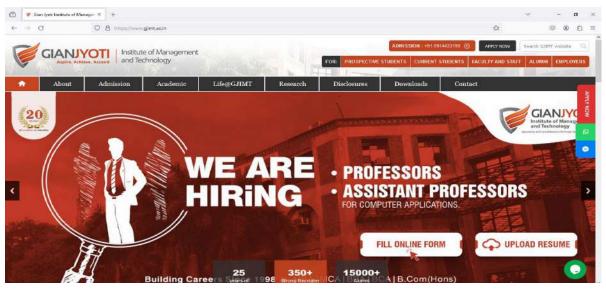


Fig: Recruitment Notice on Official Website.

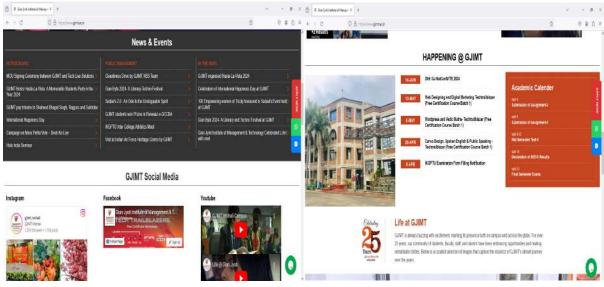


Fig: Notice Board/ Social Media and other Information Links on Official Website.

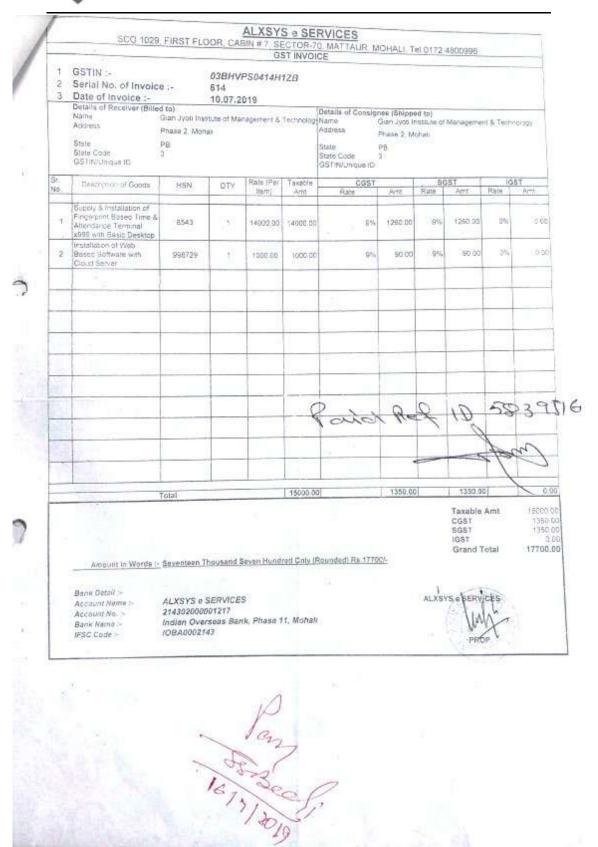

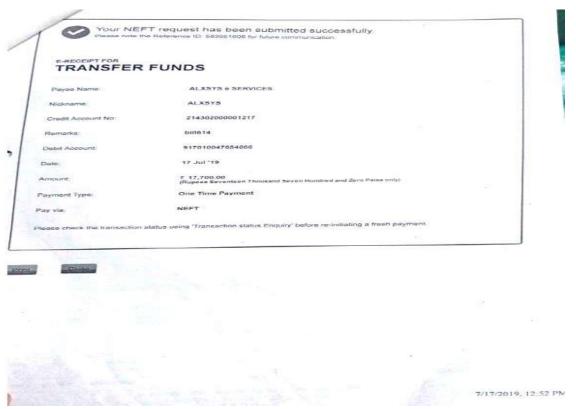

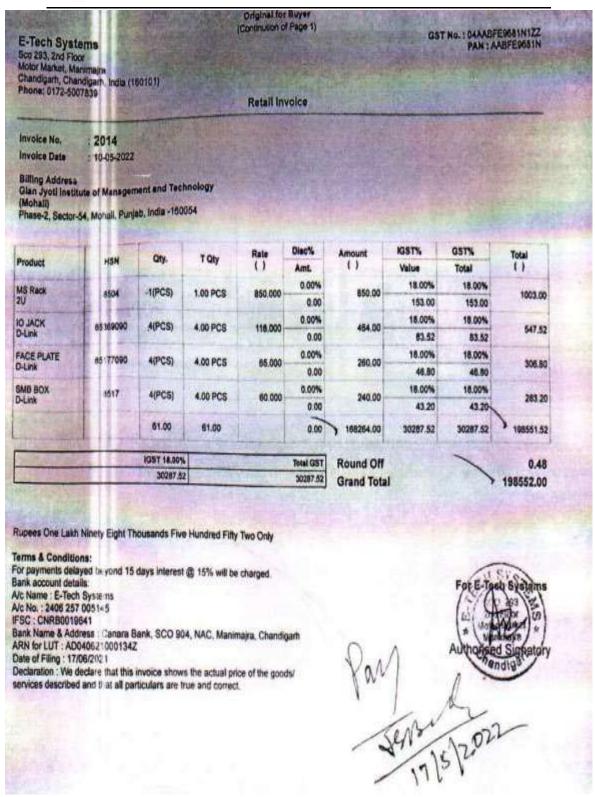


Fig: CCTV Surveillance View from the Director's Cabin, GJIMT.

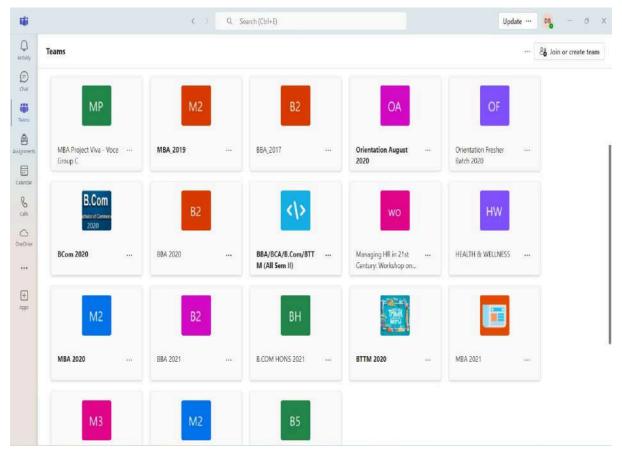


Fig: Room for different Classes through MS Teams.



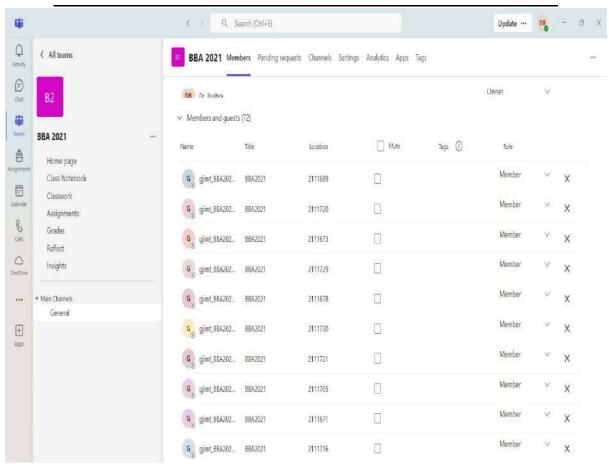


Fig: Students at Room of BBA 2021 Batch.

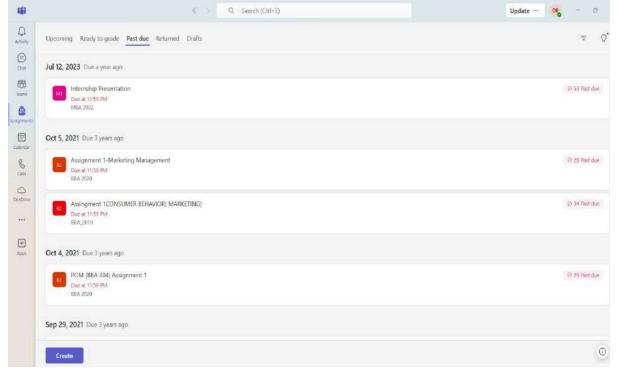


Fig: Assignments given to different classes through MS Teams

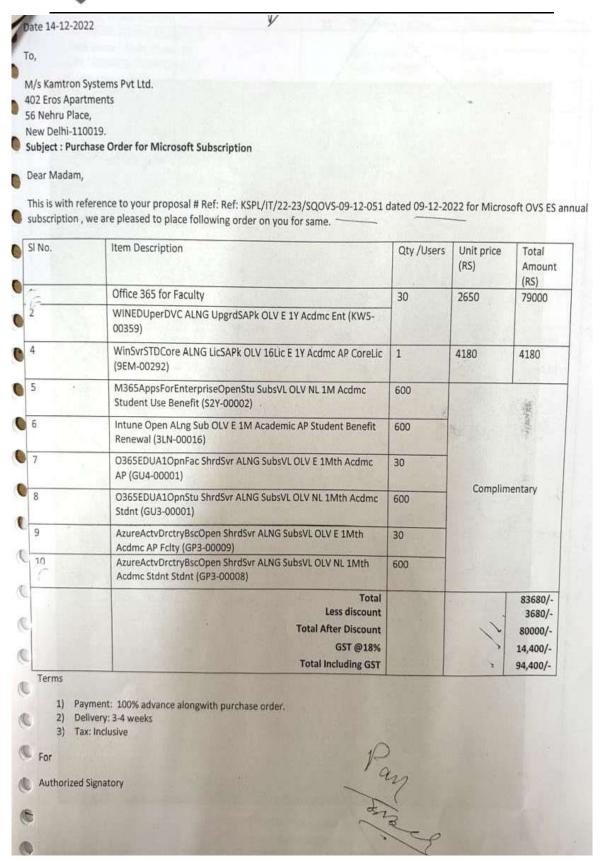

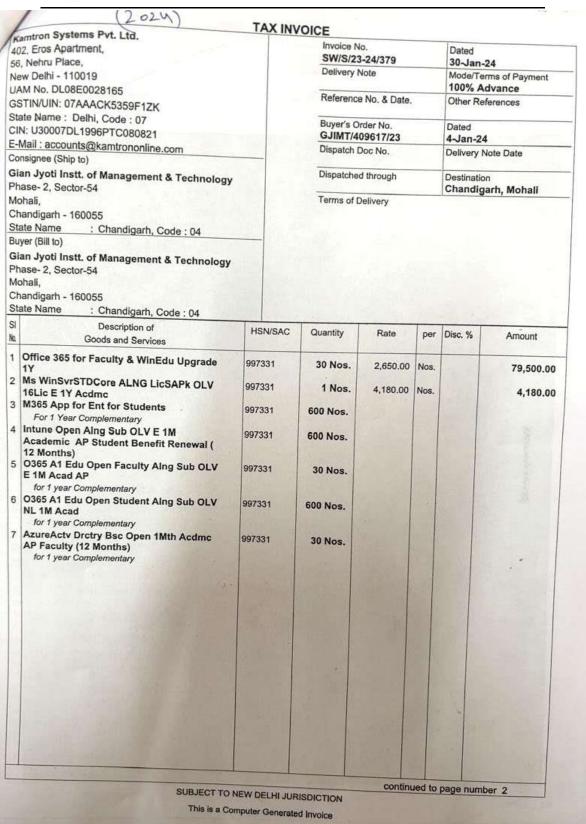

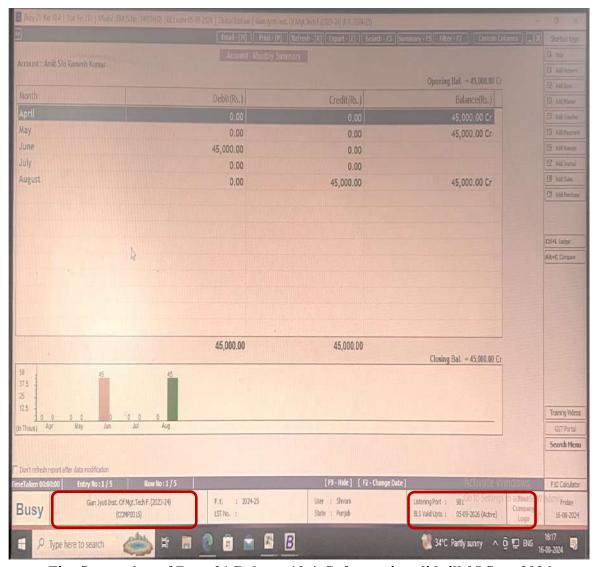


Fig: Screenshot of Busy 21 Release 10.4. Software is valid till 05 Sept 2026.

1. Student Admission Support Provided by Affiliating University (www.ptudocs.com)

The institute follows an open and transparent admission process, adhering to ethical practices and regulations set by IKGPTU. Admission guidelines, as periodically updated by IKGPTU, are prominently displayed on the institute's website.

Student Admission Support is provided by the affiliated university through www.ptudocs.com. On this portal, the following tasks are completed by the Heads of Departments (HoDs):

- 1. **Student Eligibility Lists provided by the University**: The affiliated university generates and provides a list of students who meet the eligibility criteria for admission to various courses. This list is uploaded on the portal for verification. Eligibility is typically determined based on factors like previous academic qualifications, entrance exam scores, and other requirements outlined by the university. Heads of Departments (HoDs) can access and review this list to ensure that only eligible students are enrolled in their respective courses.
- 2. Verification of Student Details (Name, Parent's Name, and Date of Birth): To ensure accuracy in official university records, the portal allows the HoD or designated staff to verify the spelling of each student's name, including their father's and mother's names, as well as their date of birth. This step is crucial for avoiding discrepancies in important documents such as transcripts, certificates, and degrees. The verification process helps ensure that official records match the details on government-issued IDs.
- 3. **Issuance of Roll Numbers by the University**: Once the student details are verified, the university generates and issues unique roll numbers for each student. These roll numbers serve as a student's identity within the university system and are used for all academic purposes, including examinations, grading, and record keeping. The roll numbers are shared via the portal, where students and HoDs can access them.
- 4. **Student Personal Login ID and Passwords shared by the University:** For each student, the university provides a personal login ID and password, which are shared through the portal. These credentials grant students access to their personal profiles on the university's online system, where they can view their academic records, course

details, grades, and other relevant information. This also allows students to interact with the University Updates or queries related to their academic journey.

- 5. Specialization and Elective Subject selection by the HoD: Depending on the program of study, students may be required to select a specialization or elective subjects. This selection is often guided by the HoD, who fills in the relevant information on the portal. The HoD ensures that students choose appropriate specializations based on their academic progress and career aspirations. This step is critical for ensuring that students meet the requirements for graduation in their chosen field of study.
- 6. Uploading of Internal Assessment Marks: Throughout the semester, students are evaluated through various internal assessments such as quizzes, assignments, and mid-term exams. Once these assessments are completed, the marks are uploaded to the portal by the HoD or designated faculty. Internal assessment marks contribute to the final grade and provide students with feedback on their progress during the course. The timely upload of these marks ensures that students are kept informed about their performance.
- 7. Uploading of Practical Marks: For courses that include practical components such as laboratory work or field studies, practical marks are uploaded to the portal by the respective faculty. Practical assessments are an essential part of the curriculum, especially in technical and science-based programs. These marks are integrated with theory marks to calculate the final grade. Accurate and prompt uploading of practical marks helps maintain transparency and ensures that students receive proper credit for their hands-on work.

These points highlight the administrative and academic processes managed through the university portal, facilitating streamlined communication and record-keeping between the university, faculty, and students.

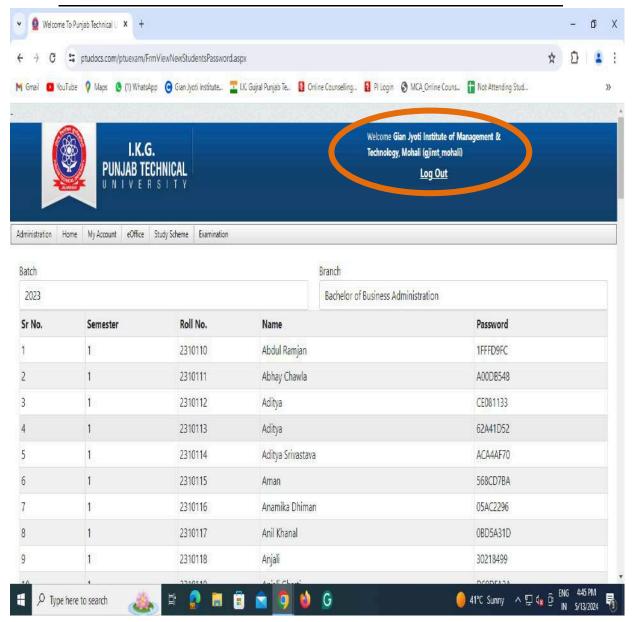


Fig: HoD accesses the web portal provided by Affiliating University through a secure login.

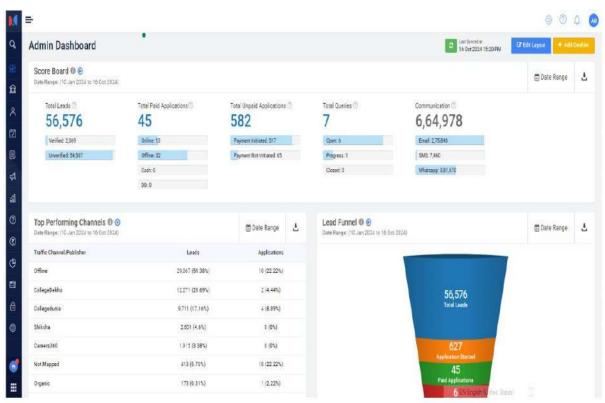


Fig: No Paper Form Web Application Dashboard

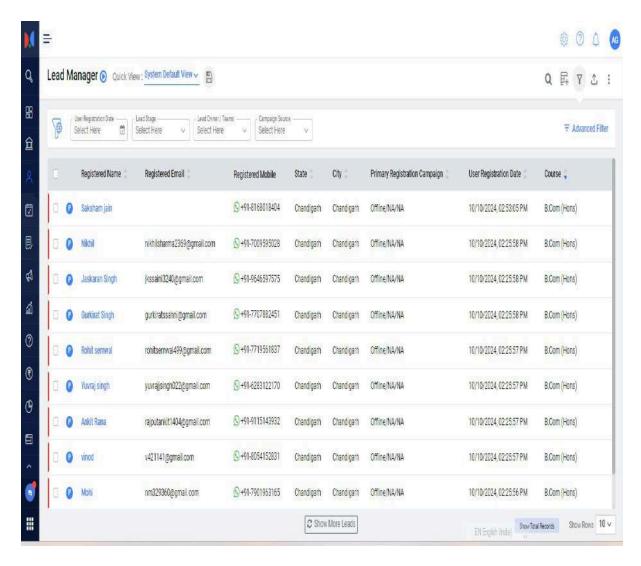


Fig: Course-wise student segregation on No Paper Form

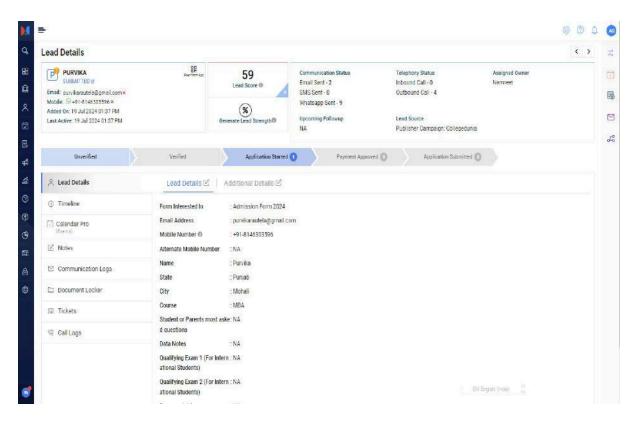


Fig: Full student details on No Paper Form

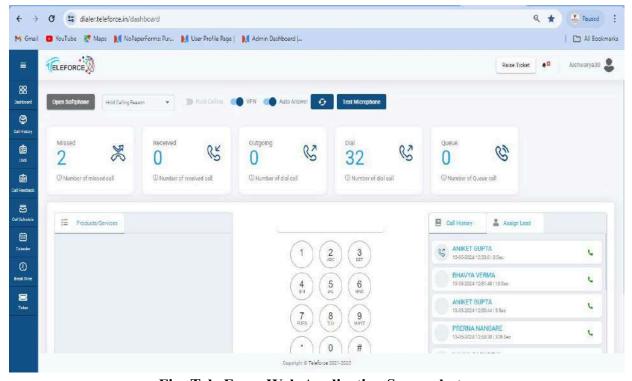


Fig: Tele Force Web Application Screenshot

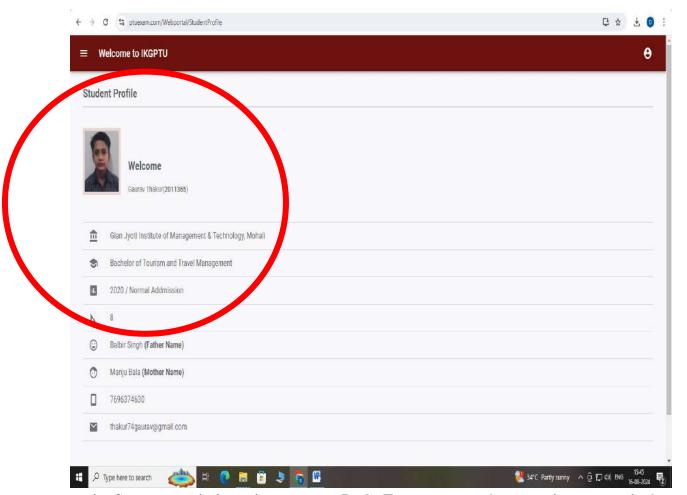


Fig: Student Login is available on the IKGPTU web portal for accessing academic & examination-related information.

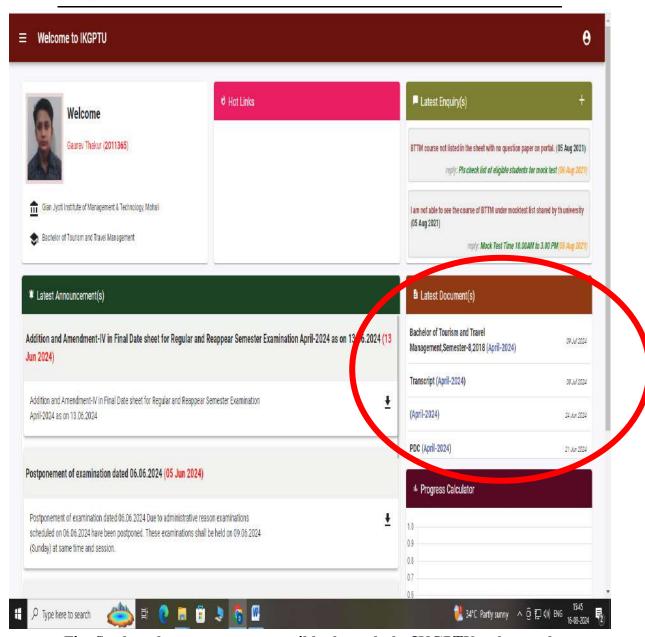


Fig: Student documents are accessible through the IKGPTU web portal.
